Derbyshire Horse & Pony Society

Derbyshire Horse & Pony Society (DHPS) was formed in 1969. On 7th June 1982 DHPS was registered as a charity. In 1983 at the suggestion of BHS it was thought that it would be better for the two horse related organisations in Derbyshire to work closely together. All of the DHPS and BHS Derbyshire County Committee members resigned and one new committee was elected. This committee was both the BHS Derbyshire Committee and DHPS committee and it was agreed that all financial details would be dealt with by the DHPS. All members of the BHS resident in Derbyshire automatically became members of DHPS. So prior to the 2010 EGM the committee and members of DHPS and BHS were the same people. All officers on the committee have been trained and approved by the relevant BHS HQ departments.

In 1984 the DHPS Charity was renamed as British Horse Society Derbyshire and the constitution was revised following suggestions from BHS Head office. In 2010 because of changes to the working arrangements between BHS Head Office and the Derbyshire Charity it has been necessary to split the 2 organisations. This was agreed by members voting at the EGM on 25th May.

The BHS Derbyshire charity (DHPS) is being renamed back to Derbyshire Horse & Pony Society to avoid confusion with the BHS Derbyshire County Committee. DHPS will continue to support Horse related activities in Derbyshire.

If anyone would like to be kept informed about the activities of the DHPS then you need to join. The annual subscription is set at £1 and will be renewable on 1st April each year. For 2010 – 2011 this can be paid in cash at the AGM. Until the official name change has been processed at the bank, cheques are not acceptable. To avoid depleting the DHPS funds it is also necessary for DHPS Founder members to pay the subscription.

John Fyale is continuing as treasurer for the DHPS and a new treasurer has been co-opted onto the BHS Derbyshire County Committee and his appointment will be voted on at the BHS Annual Meeting.

The DHPS AGM will be held at 10:30 on Sunday 17th October 2010 at Swathwick Farm, Swathwick Lane, Wingerworth, Chesterfield, S42 6QP

At the moment I am continuing as chairman of DHPS and the BHS Derbyshire County Committee.

2. Novice horses and riders are very welcome and will be given every chance to complete their test and end on a good note.
3. The event organisers reserve the right to refuse or revoke any entry without explanation.
4. The event organisers accept no responsibility for accidents, injury or loss to competitors, spectators, animals or equipment. Admission is granted and entries accepted on these conditions.
5. **All horses and riders must have adequate 3rd party insurance.**
6. The Judge's or Event Organiser's decision is final in all respects. Stewards' instructions must be adhered to.
7. British Dressage rules will be followed, except where expressly stated. All competitors are advised to download a copy of the rules from the BD website.
8. Waterproof coats and warm gloves may be worn in cold or wet weather.
9. The Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel or split any class or substitute judges without explanation.
10. Dogs are not permitted on college grounds.
11. Competitors must exercise their horses in the warm up ring only. No lunging is permitted. For safety reasons, only 4 people permitted in the warm up at any one time. Preference is given to competitors in the 20 minutes before their test time.
12. There will be **no** first aid cover at events.

Entries are accepted on the understanding that competitors agree to abide by these rules.
